## A sandwich

Purpose - to encourage good explaining and understanding skills.
We need 6 simple items necessary to make a sandwich: a chopping board, a kitchen towel, a knife, a roll, a cucumber and a cup of spreading cheese.


Students work in pairs. The teacher says that he/she doesn't know how to make a sandwich and asks students to make instructions to help him/her make a good sandwich. Students write their instructions and then are asked to read them. The teacher follows the instructions. Students are surprised that what was so obvious to them was misunderstood by the teacher.


Students learn that what we say is not always understood by others as we wish. It is necessary to give details and explain carefully our thoughts. They learn that it is not easy to understand others.
